LL.M. [CBCS] DEGREE EXAMINATIONS, JANUARY 2023 INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES

Candidates are required to read the following Instructions carefully before filling the Exam Application Form

- 1. LL.M. [CBCS] Degree Courses Semester Examinations, January 2023 will be conducted only through **OFFLINE MODE** and there is no change in the Question Paper Pattern of Examinations.
- 2. Examination Schedule and Time-Table is available in the University website and in the notice board of the institution.
- 3. The examinations of LL.M. [CBCS] Degree Courses are being conducted for the students as detailed below:
 - ➤ In respect of the students admitted for the academic year 2021-2022, the 2nd (EVEN) semester and their arrear examinations shall be conducted.
 - ➤ In respect of the students admitted to the academic year from 2017-2018 to 2020-2021, all arrear examinations shall be conducted.
- 4. Candidates shall apply for the examination only through **Online mode by visiting the University website:** www.tndalu.ac.in and submit the exam application form. The examination fee has to be paid only through the Examination application Form and the fee payment should not be done directly under the online fees payment.
- 5. The Candidates are required to register for the papers according to their Branch, Batch and Regulation and also instructed to refer the Time-Table for registering the correct subject code.
- 6. Candidates are required to upload a clear and visible recent passport size photo as the same will be printed in the Hall-Ticket & Attendance sheet.
- 7. Applications submitted through any other mode shall not be accepted.
- 8. Candidates are required to verify the details before submitting. No further corrections will be allowed.
- 9. **Visually Challenged Candidates:** Visually Challenged candidates are exempted from payment of examination fees. However they should pay the fees for Statement of marks and application cost.
- 10. The fees once paid, will in no circumstances be refunded or held over for the subsequent examinations.
- 11. Copy of the filled-in Exam Application form will be forwarded to candidate's registered Email-Id.
