INSTRUCTION TO THE CANDIDATES

Candidates are required to read the following Instructions carefully before filling the Exam Application Form

- 1. LL.M. (CBCS) Degree Courses [ODD] Semester Examinations, February 2024 will be conducted only through **OFFLINE MODE** and there is no change in the Question Paper Pattern of Examinations.
- 2. Examination Schedule and Time-Table is available in the University website and in the notice board of the institution.
- 3. The examinations of LL.M. (CBCS) Degree Courses are conducted for the students as detailed below:
 - (i) For the candidates admitted during the academic year 2023-2024 (First year students of this academic year):

 As the Academic Schedule for the 1st Semester students who admitted during the academic year 2023-2024 will be ended on 3rd April 2024, the examination for the current 1st Semester students shall be conducted in the ensuing examination scheduled to be held during April/May 2024.
 - (ii) For the candidates admitted during the academic year 2022-2023: The 3rd (ODD) Semester and their arrear examinations shall be conducted.
 - (iii) For the candidates admitted to the academic year from 2020-2021 to 2021-2022 : Permitted to write their arrear examinations.
 - (iv) For the candidates admitted prior to the academic year 2020 2021 other than re-admitted candidates:

 Not permitted to write the examinations As per UGC Guidelines of Uniform Span Period (N+2) rules and adopted by the Syndicate in its 158th Meeting held on 31.10.2018.
- 4. Candidates shall apply for the examination only through **Online mode by visiting the University website:** www.tndalu.ac.in and submit the exam application form. The examination fee has to be paid only through the Examination application Form and the fee payment should not be done directly under the online fees payment.
- 5. The Candidates are required to register for the papers according to their Branch, Batch and Regulation and also instructed to refer the Time-Table for registering the correct subject code.
- 6. Candidates are required to upload a clear and visible recent passport size photo as the same will be printed in the Hall-Ticket & Attendance sheet.
- 7. Applications submitted through any other mode shall not be accepted.
- 8. Candidates are required to verify the details before submitting. No further corrections will be allowed.
- 9. **Visually Challenged Candidates:** Visually Challenged candidates are exempted from payment of examination fees. However they should pay the fees for Statement of marks and application cost.
- 10. The fees once paid, will in no circumstances be refunded or held over for the subsequent examinations.
- 11. Copy of the filled-in Exam Application form will be forwarded to candidate's registered Email-Id.
