TheDegree ofDoctor ofPhilosophy(Ph.D.)willbeawardedtoacandidatewho, asper these regulations, submitting athesis on the basis of original and independent researchin the law discipline that makes a contribution to the advancement of knowledge, which is to be approved by Board of examiners as required.

II. (a) ELIGIBILITY FORADMISSIONTO Ph.D.INLAW:

ApplicantseekingadmissiontoPh.D. Degree Programmeshall have a**MasterofLaws Degree** [M.L. /LL.M.] from any recognized University having scored a minimum of **55%** or equivalentinitsgrade.

In the case of persons who have completed their Master's Degree prior to 1991 shall have at least a minimum of 50% marks in the Master's Degree. In the case of SC/ST and Person with Disability [PWD], 5% of concession in Marks is given as per the Government Order and the UGC regulations.

In the case of candidates applying for Part-Timeresearch, in addition to the above, they should possess the following requirements.

- [1] InthecaseofJudges, who have put innotlessthan 5years of regular service as JudicialOfficers and attended seminars and presented at least 2 Papers.
- [2] Inthecaseofteacherswho have put in1year offull-timeregularservice inthe UniversityorinanyoftheaffiliatedColleges ofthisUniversity.
- [3] In the case of lawyers and othersthose who are working in the Research Institutions/ResearchDepartmentsconnected with Law, should have put inat least 5years of professional experience and presented at least two papers in Seminars and Conferences.

II. (b)ELIGIBILITYFORADMISSIONTOPh.D.ININTER-DISCIPLINARYFIELD:

- ABachelor'sDegreein Law alongwithaMaster'sDegreein a) Engineering, Medicine, Forensic Science, Agriculture or Technology or M. Phil.in other &SocialSciencehavingscored a minimum 55% Humanities or equivalentin itsgrade(Candidates who havecompleted their Master's Degree priortotheyear1991shouldhaveatleastaminimumof50% ofmarks). However, the candidates who have a Ph.D. Degree in any discipline may also be eligible to pursue Ph.D. Degree (Inter-disciplinary) of TNDALU without Bachelors Degree in Law, subject to the condition that the nature of their contribution after acquiring their Ph.D. in their respective field including publications shall be assessed. In such cases, the topic of their research shall be related to the field of Law.
- b) Candidatewho havepassed CompanySecretaryexaminations(ACS)or Passed Charted Accountants examinations (ACA) or Passed Cost Accountant Examinations(ICWA)arealsoeligible.
- c) Inthecaseofcandidates applyingfor Part-TimeResearch. Inadditionto (a) theyshallhavepublishedatleastTwoResearchPapersin theInter-disciplinary area,whichthecandidatewishtopursue, inanyreputedJournal.

III. DURATIONOF THEPROGRAMME:

Full-Time Ph.D. Research Scholars: Theminimumduration of the Ph.D. Full-Time Programmeshallbe2years and the maximumperiod of durationshall not exceed 5 years from the date of registration.Beyond2 years,thecandidateshallpaythefeeprescribed for each year of extension.Thereshall not befurther extension of period beyond 5 years.

A candidateregistered on a full-timebasis shall work under continuoussupervision for the minimumperiod of research prescribed as above after the date of provisional registration and before submission of the thesis in the department or University. A full-timescholar shall present regularly, and the attendance of the scholar will be maintained by the supervisor duly endorsed by the HOD.

Part-Time: The minimumdurationofthe Ph.DPart-Timeprogrammeshall be3years and the maximumperiodofdurationshall not exceed 6 years from the date of registration. Beyond 3 years, the candidateshall pay the feeprescribedfor each year of extension. There shall not be furtherextensionofperiodbeyond6 years.

Acandidateregisteredonapart-time basisshallwork atleastfor**TwoMonths** inevery academic year during the course of research at the institution where the supervisor is attached. The supervisor basto based the tendance certificated use forwarded by the Head of the Department and the Head of the Institution to the Registrar.

IV.RESIDENTIALREQUIREMENTS

- 1. Acandidateregisteredonafulltimebasisshallwork undercontinuoussupervision fortheminimumperiodofresearchprescribedasaboveafterthedateofprovisional registrationandbeforesubmissionofthesisintheUniversity.
- 2. Acandidateregisteredon apart time basis shall work atleast for**T wo Months**in every academicyear during the course of researchat the institution where the supervisoris attached.

. TheEntrancetestwillbeconducted on 01-10-2016 atTheTamilNaduDr.AmbedkarLaw University, M.G.R. Salai, Perungudi, Chennai – 600 096.

The Ph.D.Entrancetestshallbe conducted asper the UGC Regulations and the testshall carry 50% of marks for descriptive and 50% of marks for multiple choice questions comprising the following subjects:

a) Constitutional Law, b) InternationalLaw, c) Jurisprudence and d)ResearchMethodology.

The successful candidate satthe Entrancetest shall present their research proposals at the viva-voce/Interview before the admission Committee.

VIII.CONVERSION OF FULL-TIME REGISTRATION INTO PART-TIME AND VICE-VERSA.

Notwithstandinganythingprescribedintheseregulations,theUniversitymay permitconversionfrom full time researchtopart time researchand vice-versain respectof candidates registered,for valid reasonsand subject to satisfyingthe regulations,rulesand conditionsinforce.Theperiodput inbythecandidatewillbe workedoutintheratioof2:3forresearchputinbeforeandaftersuchconversion.

CHANGEOFSUPERVISOR/TOPIC

Changeofsupervisorcan be permitted with mutual consentgiven by both the original and proposed guide.

Incase of change of supervisor is proposed without the consent of any one of the parties concerned, the matter shall be referred to the Board of Research Studies, whose decisions hall be final.

The supervisors who wish to avail leave/lien/deputationbeyondaperiodofSIX MONTHS shall nominate co-guides in the concerned subject for the candidates registered with them and the fact intimated to the University in advance.

IX.BOARDOF RESEARCHSTUDIES

Inordertoregulatetheentire ResearchProgrammes,theUniversityhasaBoard of Research Studies.TheBoard ofResearch Studiesshall consist of the Vice-Chancelloras Chairman,allthe

Directorsofthe Universityand not more than three memberseither from the Vice-ChancellorsofNationalLaw Universitiesorfrom the Deans of any Law Departmentofany other University, shall be members. The Registrarshall be the Member Secretary of the Board of Research Studies. The Board of Research Studies normally may meet once in a year.

X. INDEPENDENT RESEARCH

Subjecttoother provisions in the regulations, the following categories of persons may be permitted to conduct independent research for Ph.D(i.e. without a Guide) with the approval of the Doctoral Committee.

Judges with aminimum periodof5years ofJudicial Servicenotlower than therank of District Judge and with active participationin seminar/Conference/Workshopetc., maybepermittedtoregisterforPh.DwithoutaGuide.

These candidatesare required to submita report to the DoctoralCommittee and present seminarsonce insixmonths during the period of research. They are also required to submit research reports to the DoctoralCommittee annually from their date of registration for independent research.

XI.(a) EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION

Part-I: COURSEWORKEXAMINATIONANDEVALUATION

Every candidateprovisionallyregisteredforthe Ph.D.Programmeshall undertake **course work** foraminimumperiodofone semester.Thecourse work consists of the following:

(b)SCHEMEOFEXAMINATIONS:

TheDoctoralCommitteewillconductthewrittenexaminationfor3papers,each of3hoursdurationcarrying100markseachand alsotheViva-voce. Theresultswillbe publishedbytheUniversityand communicatedtotheeligible candidatesthroughDean, Research Studies.

Onthebasisofthese examinations, provisional registration of the candidates will be confirmed by the University. He/Sheshall bepermitted to proceed with/herresearch work and submitthe thesis at the expiry of minimum total period of research prescribed after provisional registration. The candidates hould give seminar speriodically after the confirmation of registration in the general field and in the topics connected with his/her research work.

XII. DOCTORALCOMMITTEE

- 1. There shall beaDoctoralCommitteetoreviewtheprogressoftheresearchwork at he end of every sixmonthsofthe prescribed period of Ph.D. Research till the submission of thesis.
- 2. The Doctoral committeeshall consist of the Guide and not less than two othermembers of the faculty who are recognized supervisors/guides The Doctoral Committeeshall be constituted by the Vice-Chancelloron the recommendation of the Guide. The Guide shall be the Convener.
- 3. The candidateswho are permitted register for Ph.D. without Guide, shall submithiswork on the subject of his research to the Doctoral Committee at the end of every sixmonths. In such cases the Vice-Chancellorshall constitute the committee and thes eniormost among members shall be the Convenor.
- 4. The Doctoral Committee shall review the Research Report submitted by the candidateand the candidateshall be permitted proceedfurther, if only, the DoctoralCommittee is satisfied with the progress of the Research work of the candidates.
- 5. The DoctoralCommittee shall discussadvice and recommendon all matters connected with the candidates research from the date of provisional registration till the submission of the thesis.
- 6. Tomonitorthecandidatesresearchwork, theDoctoralCommitteeshallmeetonce insixmonthsandmaydirect thecandidate.
 - i. togiveperiodicalseminarsonthework.
 - ii. mayexaminetheperiodicalreportssubmittedonceinsixmonthsinthe caseoffulltimecandidatesand once inayear inthe caseofpart time candidatesto the Universityon the candidate'sprogressin research work intheprescribedformat.
 - iii. TheDoctoralCommitteeshallconductand superviseapresentationby thecandidate ofthefinaldraft ofhis/herproposedthesis forapproval before thesubmissionofsynopsis ofthethesis totheUniversityand to giveacertificatetothiseffecttobesubmitted alongwiththesynopsis.

XIII.TERMINATIONOF CANDIDATURE

- 1. If in the opinion of the Doctoral Committee a candidate's work is unsatisfactory, the committee shall ask the candidate to show cause why his/hercandidature should not be terminated.
- 2. The submission of the concerned candidate to the show cause notice shall beconsidered by the Doctoral Committee, which may there on recommend to the Vice- Chancellor that the candidate be allowed to continue with his/herresearchor that the candidature beterminated.
- 3. After considerationoftherecommendationsoftheCommittee,theVice-Chancellor may either permitthecandidatetocontinuewith his/herresearchorterminatethe candidatureorpermitthecandidaturetore-enrollspecifying conditionsforsuchre-enrollmentontheapproval oftheBoardofResearch Studies.
- 4. If the candidate does not respond to the show notice. then cause on therecommendationsofthe DoctoralCommittee.the Vice-Chancellorshall terminate candidatureofthe concernedstudentand the Registrarshall officially inform the studentofsuchtermination.

- 5. Astudentwhose candidatureisterminatedunderRegulation(X4)shall have aright of appeal to the Board of Research Studies. Such an appeal should be submittedinwritingwithin60 daysfromthedate offreceipt offheorder.
- 6. TheBoard ofResearch Studiesonproperexaminationofthecasemay either uphold the DoctoralCommittee'sdecisionor may reversesuch decisionor may take any other appropriatedecisioninthematter.TheDecision oftheBoard ofResearch Studiesshallbe placedbeforetheSyndicateforappropriateaction.

XIV. SUBMISSIONOF SYNOPSIS

1. Notlessthan THREEmonthsbefore thesubmissionofthethesis, every candidateshall submittotheUniversity,throughhis/herGuide ortheDoctoralCommitteewhichever ispertinent,aSynopsis(SIXCOPIES) along with asoft copy of the proposed thesis togetherwith the certificate of the Doctoral Committee andthetitleofthethesis stating tobepresented with the letter of aguide along with the prescribed fee. The Candidate shall inform of submission of his/herthesis the probabledate inthe application.The synopsisshallnotexceed20 typewrittenorprintedpages (onesideonlyofA4size).

- 2. Before the submission of the Synopsis, the candidateshould present a seminaron his/herPh.D.thesis and theDoctoralCommitteeshould send asuitability report of the same and approving the title of the thesis while forwarding the synopsis.
- 3. Not later than SIXMONTHS after thesubmissionofthesynopsisand after theexpiry of the minimumperiodof researchprescribed, every candidates hall submitFIVECOPIES of the thesisem bodying the result of the research carried outby him/heralong with the prescribed fee.

XV.SUBMISSIONOF THETHESIS

Ph.D. Scholarsshall submittheir draft thesis withinareasonabletime. They shall publishatleastone researchpaperin a referred journal before submission of his/her thesis.

- 1. Thetitlepage ofthethesis, cover, format,etc.,shouldstrictly conformtotheformatof presentationasprescribedand thethesis (allcopies) shouldcarry adeclarationbythe candidatetotheeffectthat theresearchcarriedout isoriginaloneand that itdoes not form part ofany researchcarriedout earlier and the same isto beduly signedand issuedbythe Supervisor.Thethesis shouldbehardboundand itshouldhave athin andflexiblecoveralongwithasoftcopyinaCDform.
- 2. Nocandidateshall bepermittedtosubmitthethesis after aperiodofFIVEYEARSin thecaseofFull-Time, SIXYEARSinthecaseofPart-Timeresearch.Theregistrationof thecandidate,who isnotabletosubmithis/herthesiseven aftertheabove mentioned period,standscancelled.

3. However, if a candidate who has not submitted the thesis at the end of the FIFTH YEAR, SIXTHYEAR as the case may be, the candidate shall be permitted to RE-register with in a period of one year. In such cases the candidate shall submit the thesis with in a period of one year from the date of re-registration on payment of fee as prescribed from time to time.

4. EXTENSIONOFTIMEANDCANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION

Nocandidateshallordinarilybepermittedtosubmitthethesis after aperiodof5 years incase of full time research scholars and 6 years in the case of part time research scholars provided University that the may for valid reasons and on the recommendationsofhis/hersupervisor, grant extensionoftimefornotmore than two years in all, to the candidatesafter paymentof prescribed fees for every vear of Extension.Theregistrationofthe candidate,who isnot able tosubmithis/herthesis evenafterthegrant of extension of 2 years, stands cancelled.

XVI.ADJUDICATIONOF THEPh.D.THESIS

- 1. The candidateshall berequired to submitto the Registrar,FIVECOPIES of his/her thesis (allthefivecopies toberetained by the University) embodying the results of the candidates research work. The length of the thesis shall conform to the requirements as prescribed by the Doctoral Committee.
- 2. The thesis shall be in English and shall be the result of candidate'soriginalwork attaining as a tight and a training as a tight of the term of term of
- 2. Beforeacandidatesubmitsthesis, the supervisormust besatisfied astowhether the thesis conforms to the requirements of the prescribed Rules and acertificate to this effect from the Guide shall accompany the thesis when it is submitted. If the Guide does not so certify, the Guide shall submit are port to the Registraralong with the candidates written submission, if any, shall be placed before the Board of Research Studies for consideration and recommendation.
- 4. After a candidate hassubmitted thesis, theDoctoral Committee, on the recommendationoftheGuide concerned,shallsubmit apanel ofsixexternalexaminers to the Vice-Chancellor. The Vice-Chancellorshall choose any three nameswithin the panel submitted by the DoctoralCommittee after getting approval of the Syndicate. Evaluation of *Synopsis/Thesis* shall be referred to 3 examiners and all the three examiners shall be from outside the state and to be selected from the panel of examinerssubmitted by the Guide. The Guide shall not be an examiner in the evaluation of the thesis.
- 5. The examinersshall submittheir reportofevaluation in the prescribed form to the University giving their assessment of the thesis and their recommendations as to whether the degreeshall or shall not be awarded to the candidate. In the critical assessment of the thesis examiners shall indicate to whether the thesis may be accepted after effecting minorrevision or correction duly reviewed and endorsed by the Guide on astowhether additional work should be undertaken by the candidate for revision and resubmission or whether the thesis should be rejected outright.
- **5.**[A]Incase,thesupervisorfailedtoprovidethelistofexaminersevenaftertwomonthly reminders,then the Dean, Research Studiesmay be requested to provide the list of examiners.If the supervisorhappensto be the Dean, Research studies, the panel of

examinersshall beobtained from the Chairmanof the BORS inconsultation with the specialist in that field.

If all the three examiners unanimously recommend the award of the degree, there shall be vivavoceexaminationofthe candidateconductedby one ofthe three examiners whoevaluatedthethesis.If aftersuchexaminationtheviva-voceexaminerconfirmsthe decision of the thesis examiners to award the degree to the candidate and shall recommendtheawardofthedegreetoSyndicate.TheSyndicateshallthen approvethe awardofthedegree.OntheapprovaloftheSyndicatethedegreeshall beawardedto thecandidateand shall beduly notifiedbytheUniversitytoallconcernedand tothe other LawUniversitiesinIndia. ThedegreeshallbeconferredattheConvocationofthe University. The candidate shall be eligible to obtain a Provisional Certificate on paymentoftheprescribed fee.

7. **RE-SUBMISSIONOFTHESIS**

Acandidatewhose thesis hasnotbeen commendedfortheawardofdegreemay be permittedtoresubmititonasecondoccasion withinaperiodofoneyearfromthedate of declaration of the results with a specific statement from the candidate and supervisorabout the additional researchwork conducted and revisiondone in the thesisonthelinessuggested by the Board of Examiners. The resubmitted thesis shall be referred to the same examiners who originally valued the thesis for re-evaluation.

XVII.FORMATOF THE DEGREE

ThePh.D.Degree Certificateshallincorporate the title of the thesis along with the name of the discipline–LAW. Asoft copy of the Ph.D. thesis will be submitted to the UGC within a period of third days for hosing the same in flibnet.

XVIII. SIGNATORY OF THE DEGREE

The Ph.D. Certificate shall be signed only by the Vice-Chancellor of this University.

Theprovisional certificate will be issued certifying to the effect that the Ph.D.D egree has been awarded in accordance with the provisions of the UGC (Minimum Standard s and Procedure for award of Ph.D.D egree), Regulations 2016.

XIX.PUBLICATIONOFTHETHESIS

TheVice-Chancellorshallgrant permissionforpublicationofanapprovedPh.D.,thesis onarequestfromthecandidate afterduly certifiedbythesupervisorthat theconnections suggestedbyother twoexaminers,ifany,havebeencarriedoutinthethesis.

XX.FEE STRUCTURE-Ph.D.PROGRAMME
